1. INVITATION

The Chess Confederation of the Americas (CCA), the Ecuadorian Chess Federation (FEDA), is pleased to invite all the National Chess Federations of the American Continent, to the Women's Continental Chess Championship of the Americas 2022, which will be held from December 5 to 10, 2022, in the city of Cuenca, province of Azuay - Ecuador.

Santa Ana de los Ríos de Cuenca is located in an inter-Andean valley of the Ecuadorian Sierra Austral. Cuenca is the capital of the province of Azuay, the third largest city in Ecuador and the economic center of the southern highlands. These distinctions, together with the incredible level of conservation of its historical and cultural heritage have led Cuenca to be named by the UNESCO as Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

OF THE ORGANIZATION.

The Women's Continental Championship is organized by the Ecuadorian Chess Federation – FEDA -.

2. OF THE PARTICIPANTS

Official players: These athletes are entitled to accommodation and full food by the organization, from Sunday, December 4 at 2 pm until Sunday, December 11 at 2 pm:

- An athlete appointed by the Continental President
- Up to 3 athletes from zone 2.1
- An athlete from zone 2.2
- Up to 2 athletes from each of zones 2.3, 2.4, and 2.5
- The 2021 Women's Continental Champion.
- The Pan American Champion Junior
- An athlete invited by the Organization.

The official athletes will be accommodated in a double room. Their designation will have to be notified to the organization by the presidents of each zone, no later than November 30, 2022.

Unofficial players:

The Women's Continental Championship is an <u>open tournament</u> (with no minimum requirement from FIDE ELO). Each National Federation may register the chess players it wishes. All participants must cover their registration, transportation and accreditation costs. Each of the participants must have the endorsement of their Federation belonging to the Chess Confederation for America, registered in FIDE, unless otherwise advised by the President of the CEC.

3. INSCRIPTIONS

Official athletes must be registered by the corresponding Federations before the end of November 22, 2022, by mail sent to the Ecuadorian federation ofez@gmail.com. After that deadline all athletes will be considered unofficial.

No player may be registered without the approval of her own Federation or if she does not belong to the region corresponding to this tournament.

For an athlete's registration to be considered completed, she must provide the following information: Full names and surnames, identity document (passport number), FIDE ID, current passport size photograph, full date of birth (in the format mm-dd-yyyy), FIDE title. This information must be corroborated upon arrival by presenting the passport or identity document for verification purposes.

Participants must pay for registration the sum of TWO HUNDREDAMERICAN DOLLARS (USD \$ 200.00). This amount includes the CCA fee (\$100)

The extra athletes and companions will have their insurance, once they have confirmed their participation with the respective deposits.

The aforementioned payment is mandatory to make it before the first round to take part in the event. <u>Each Federation will be jointly and severally liable</u> for the payment of the <u>registrations made and for the costs caused by the non-presentation of the registered players.</u>

Registration payments can be made before the start of the tournament in the city of Cuenca.

The Pareos and pgns will be published one hour after the conclusion of each round in Chess-Results.com

According to the FIDE HANDBOOK, (International Title Regulations), obtaining the gold medal will give the direct title of WGM. In case of a tie for first place, it will give each of the tied athletes, WGM rule.

The athletes who obtain the 2nd and 3rd place will obtain the WIM title.

8. OF THE SPECIFIC RULES OF THE GAME

8.1 SYSTEM AND RHYTHM OF PLAY.

The tournament will be played by the Swiss system to 9 rounds, according to the Swiss Manager program. All games must be played with an electronic clock. A game rhythm of 90 minutes will be used for the first 40 plays plus 30 minutes to finish, with an increment of 30 seconds per play from the start.

For the Swiss system, the following will be used, in strict order:

- Sonneborn-berger
- Medium Bucholz.

The champion will qualify for the "FIDE World Cup" phase of the world championship cycle.

<u>In case of a tie for first place</u>, it will be defined as follows:

- <u>Draw between 2 players</u>: 2 games at 15 minutes per player, with an additional 10 seconds from the first move. If the tie persists, two other games will be played at 5 minutes with an additional 3 seconds each. If the tie is maintained, a game will be playedwhere White will have 5 minutes and Black 4 minutes, with an additional 3 seconds each. The player who wins the draw chooses color; In case of a tie, the player will win with the black pieces.
- <u>Tie between 3 or more players</u>: Round Robin at 15 minutes per player, plus 10 seconds per play from the start. In case of a tie, the tiebreaker of the Women's Continental tournament will be applied.

The tournament will be valid for the International Rating and will give titles and rules according to the regulations of "FIDE Titles"

10. APPEALS COMMITTEE

An Appeals Committee will be elected during the technical meeting. It will be made up of three (3) members and 2 alternates. A protest against an arbitral decision must be submitted in writing to the Appeals Committee within 2 hours of the end of the round, accompanied by a deposit of USD 70, which will be returned if the decision is favorable to the claimant.

11. PAYMENT METHOD.
