QUALIFIER TO THE "WORLD CUP 2023". DIRECT TITLES OF GRANDMASTER AND INTERNATIONAL MASTER

INVITATION

The Chess Confederation of the Americas (CCA), the Cuban Chess Federation (FCA), are pleased to invite all the National Chess Federations of the American Continent, to the XIV Women's Continental Chess Championship of the Americas 2023, to be held from May 6 to 12, 2023, in the city of Havana - Cuba, as part of the LVI edition of the international tournament Capablanca in Memoriam.

Havana, located in the north of the island, founded in the 16th century, with a rich chess tradition and culture, will host for the first time the best and brightest of the American continent. The so called "Wonder City" was chosen by the Swiss foundation New7Wonders in 2016 for its mythical attractiveness, the warm and welcoming atmosphere, the charisma and joviality of its inhabitants.

THE ORGANIZATION.

The XIV Women's Continental Championship is an official event of the Chess Confederation for America, organized by the Cuban Chess Federation – FCA – and is part of the FIDE World Championship cycle.

1. PARTICIPANTS

Official players: These athletes are entitled to accommodation and full board at the expense of the organization, from Saturday, May 6 at 2 p.m. until Saturday, May 13 at 12 noon:

- One sportswoman designated by the Continental President
- Up to 3 sportswomen from zone 2.1
- One athlete from zone 2.2
- Up to 2 athletes from each of the zones 2.3, 2.4, and 2.5
- The Women's Continental Champion of the year 2022.
- The U20 Pan American Champion.
- An athlete invited by the Organization.

The official athletes will be accommodated in double rooms. Their designation will have to be notified to the Organization by the Presidents of each Zone no later than April 15, 2023. Unofficial players:

The Women's Continental Championship is an open tournament (no minimum FIDE ELO requirement). Each National Federation may enter as many players as it wishes. All participants must cover their registration, transportation and accreditation costs. Each participant must have the endorsement of her Federation belonging to the Chess Confederation for America, registered with FIDE, unless otherwise stated by the CCA.

2. REGISTRATION







The official sportswomen must be registered by the corresponding Federations before the end of April 20, 2023, by mail sent to federacioncubanadeajedrez@gmail.com. After this deadline, all athletes will be considered unofficial.

No player can be registered without the approval of her own Federation or if she does not belong to the region corresponding to this tournament.

In order for an athlete's registration to be considered complete, she must provide the following information: Full name and surname, identity document (passport number), FIDE ID, current passport size photograph, complete date of birth (in mm-dd-yyyy format), FIDE title. This information must be corroborated upon arrival by presenting the passport or identity card for verification purposes.

Participants must pay a registration fee of TWO HUNDRED AMERICAN DOLLARS (USD \$200.00). This amount includes the CCA fee (\$100).

Extra athletes and accompanying persons will be insured once they have confirmed their participation with the respective deposits.

This payment must be made before the first round in order to take part in the event. Each Federation will be jointly and severally responsible for the payment of the inscriptions made and the costs caused by the non-presentation of the registered players.

Registration payments can be made before the start of the tournament in the city of Havana.

3. PLACE OF PLAY

The place of play will be the Habana Libre Hotel, venue of the 1966 Olympiad, located at the corner of 23rd and L Streets, Vedado, Plaza de la Revolución neighborhood, Havana, Cuba.

In case of a tie, the prizes will be added and divided among the players with the same score, cutting in the 8th place and deciding by the system established in the rules.

Pairings and pgns will be published one hour after the conclusion of each round in Chess-Results.com.







According to the FIDE HANDBOOK, (International Title Regulations), obtaining the gold medal will give the direct title of WGM. In case of a tie for the first place, it will give each of the tied sportswomen the WGM norm.

The athletes who obtain the 2nd and 3rd place will obtain the WIM title.

7. SPECIFIC RULES OF THE GAME

7.1 SYSTEM AND PACE OF PLAY.

The tournament will be played by the Swiss system in 9 rounds, according to the Swiss Manager program. All games must be played with an electronic clock. A pace of play of 90 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move from the start shall be used. With a tolerance of 30 minutes from the start of the round.

The champion will qualify to the "FIDE World Cup" phase, of the world championship cycle.

The tournament will be valid for the International Rating and will give titles and norms according to the "FIDE Titles" regulations.

9. APPEALS COMMITTEE

An Appeals Committee will be elected during the technical meeting. It shall be composed of three (3) members and two (2) alternates. A protest against a referee's







decision must be submitted in writing to the Appeals Committee within 2 hours after the end of the round, accompanied by a deposit of 70 USD, which will be returned if the decision is favorable to the claimant.
